## **MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL TIME!**

The new **ONCARD** (Online National Collection And Remittal of Dues) system is up and running nationwide this year. We no longer collect dues locally. All dues (new and renewing) are paid directly to the national office of the AGO. **Renewals received locally will be returned to you with information on how to renew online.**

**Renewing members** with a valid email will soon receive an email from the AGO with an invoice and login instructions. Members without a valid email (or any email) will receive their renewal invoice by postal mail in May, along with instructions on how to renew online (and add an email address).

Everyone will have the option of paying with a credit/debit card, or may print out an invoice and mail a check to the AGO National Office (*again, not to the Louisville Chapter*). Patron Fund donations may be made online with the same transaction. The Louisville Chapter *will* accept local payment for Patron Fund donations only.

**KEEP US UP-TO-DATE!** When you renew/join, please be sure all of your personal information is current in the ONCARD database. Please be sure to include any work/church/synagogue information you normally would have included on the old membership form. We will use the ONCARD database information to build the 2014/2015 Louisville Chapter Yearbook. Whatever information you include (or exclude) in the ONCARD database when you renew or join will be included (or excluded) in the Louisville Chapter Yearbook. Also, if you are available for substitute work, be sure to indicate that in the personal information section in the ONCARD database.
