Jaime Carini maintains an active career as organist, pianist, and music educator. She studies for the Doctor of Music in Organ Performance and Literature at Indiana University where her teachers include Chris Young and Bruce Neswick. Previously, Ms. Carini served as Dean and Sub-Dean of the Tulsa AGO Chapter. Recent performances include the U.S. debut of Naji Hakim's *The Apostles* for organ duo. An avid chamber musician, Jaime performed at the OK Mozart International Festival and the Meadowmount School of Music in upstate New York.

Stephen C. Price holds a BM degree in organ performance from Western Connecticut State University; the MM from Indiana University and is currently finishing a DMA at IU as a student of Janette Fishell. Upon receiving a Fulbright Grant to France, he earned the *Diplôme d'Études Musicales* avec mention *très bien* (the equivalent of a US Artist Diploma) in the Conservatoire National de Région de Toulouse as well as *le Prix François Vidal* from the conservatory.
