## **LET'S PARTY - JANUARY 4**

The directions to **214 Potter's Lane/Clarksville IN** are as follows:

Cross Kennedy Bridge (I-65) into Indiana. (Or Clark Bridge but then get on I-65).

Follow I-65 north for 5 miles to exit 5. Take exit 5 (Veteran's Parkway) and turn left toward Clarksville. Third traffic signal (pretty sure it is the 3rd one) is Broadway Street. Make a right turn on Broadway Street (this is just before the Target Store - and Clarksville town hall is on the right when you turn on Broadway Street.)

Broadway Street becomes Potter's Lane - well, first it becomes Green Tree North and then Broadway Street - really just about a block each. Follow Potter's Lane for about a mile. House is on left (214). You will see big lighted sign for radio station. House will have some Christmas lights and it is right next to the radio station. Circular driveway for parking or parking at the radio station is ok.
