

Ascension & Holy Trinity Episcopal Church in Wyoming, Ohio seeks a part-time [15-20 hours per week] Minister of Music.

We are a suburban, community-minded, outreach-focused Episcopal parish located in Wyoming, Ohio, 10 minutes north of downtown Cincinnati, Ohio. We celebrate one sung Eucharist every Sunday at the 10:00am service and on holy days. We also have occasional Evensong and Lessons & Carols services. Our choir is 22 voices strong and includes 4 paid soloist/section leaders. In recent years the music of Taizé and some of the contemporary music of the Episcopal Church has been well received. The Minister of Music reports to the Rector of Ascension & Holy Trinity.

General Expectations:

- . Work closely and creatively with the Rector in liturgical and music planning, and be responsible for all musical aspects of worship at Ascension & Holy Trinity, including weddings, funerals, and guest and substitute musicians.
- . Be the primary organist and choir director at the 10.00m Sunday service.
- . Train, rehearse and grow both the Chancel Choir and the Handbell Choir.
- . Support and advise the Minister of the Youth Choir.
- . Be responsible for maintaining excellence in traditional Anglican choral music and hymnody at the 10.00am service, while being open to elements from the best of other sacred music traditions.
- . Grow the Congregation's interest in and engagement in sacred music.
- . Oversee all use and maintenance of our organ, pianos and handbells.
- . Be an active member of the Ascension & Holy Trinity Church Family.

Resources:

- . Many enthusiastic and supportive music ministries including the Chancel Choir, the Handbell Choir and the Youth Choir.
- . Our organ is a Phoenix 3-manual hybrid organ with 57 ranks, installed in 2013.
- . In the Chancel, a 1931 Steinway grand piano, refurbished in 2014, accompanies the Youth Choir, Communion Hymns, songs, etc.
- . A set of handbells, refurbished in 2016.
- . A Baldwin baby-grand piano in the choir rehearsal room.
- . An endowment fund for sheet music purchases.

Requirements:

- . B.M. or B.A. in Music.
- . Skilled in accompaniment and choral directing as well as encouraging congregational singing.
- . Experience and competence with sacred music.
- . Self-motivated, diligent and creative.
- . Friendly, approachable and with a good sense of humor.
